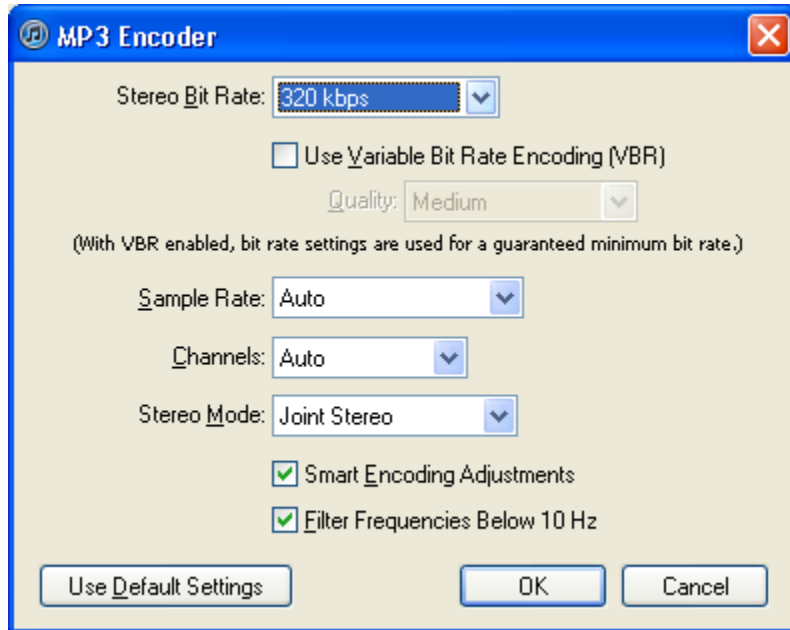


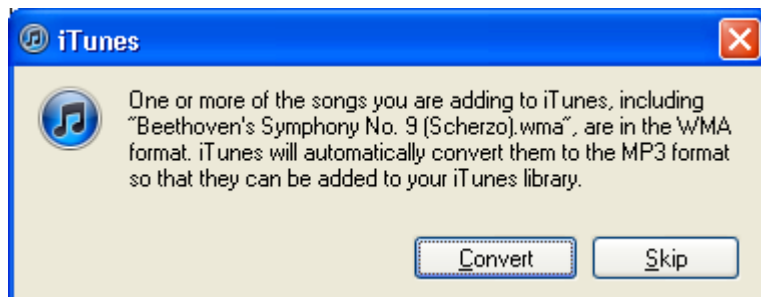
## WMA to MP3 Conversion using iTunes

This is a quick tutorial on how to convert your Windows Music files over to MP3. There are many ways to do this. This tutorial shows you how to do it using iTunes.

- 1) Download the latest version of iTunes from apple.com
- 2) Install iTunes but do not allow it to search for new music at this time.
- 3) Once iTunes is installed go into the Edit menu. Choose Preferences.
- 4) Click on the button called "Import Settings". It's located just below center of the preferences box.
- 5) In the first drop down choose "MP3 Encoder". In the second drop down choose "Custom". A new box should pop up.
- 6) In this box click the first drop down and choose "320 kbps". (see below) Click OK when done.



- 7) Now click OK on the import settings box. And OK again on the preferences box. iTunes is now ready for your media.
- 8) In iTunes go to the File menu, choose Add Folder To Library. Now browse out to the folder that contains your Windows music files and select it.
- 9) After clicking OK, You should receive a prompt telling you it will convert your .wma files to mp3 format. Click Convert to continue.



- 10) All of your files will be converted and moved into the iTunes media folder. (usually found here: My Music\iTunes\iTunes Media)
